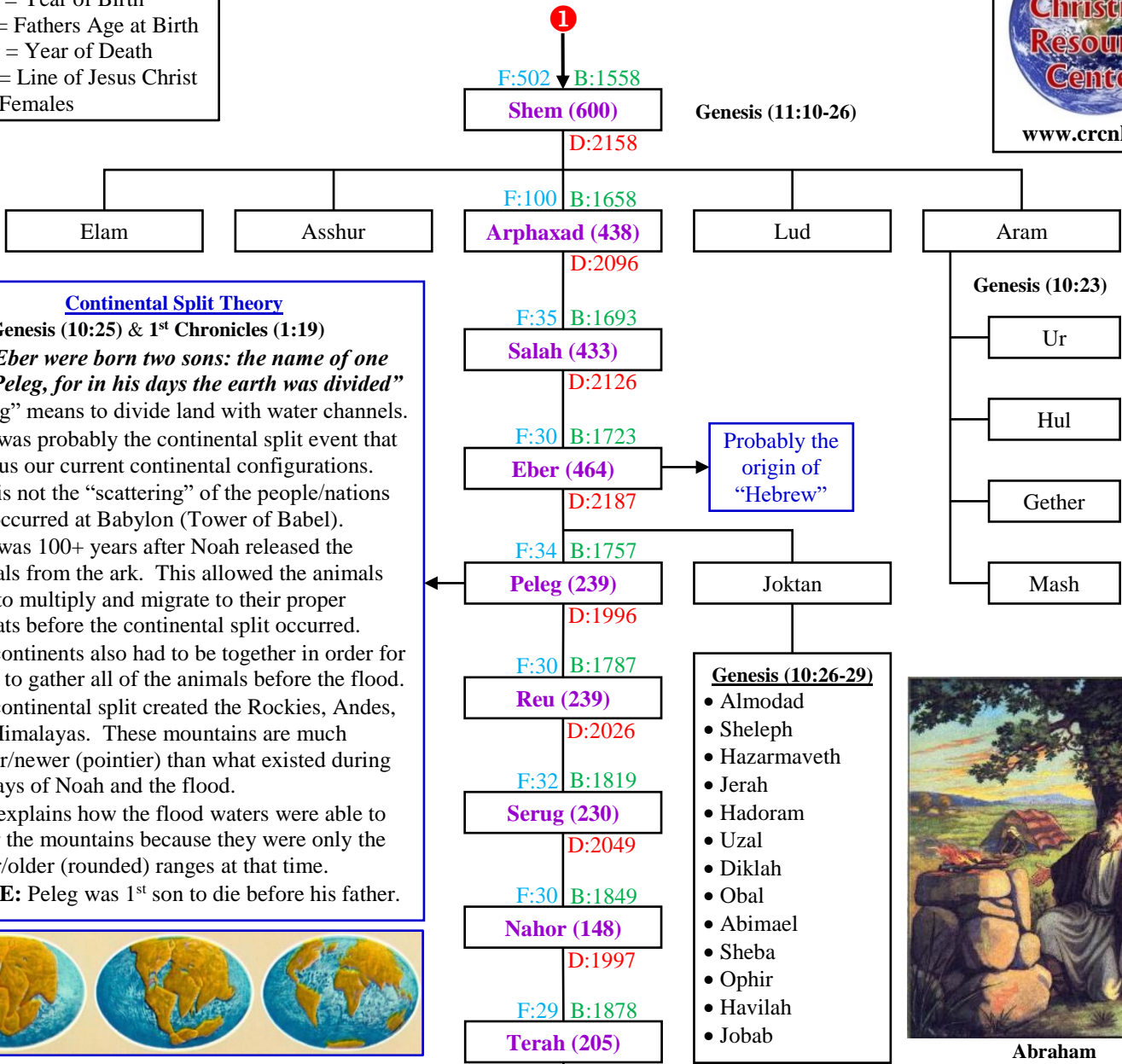


18 - Shem to Abram Genealogy

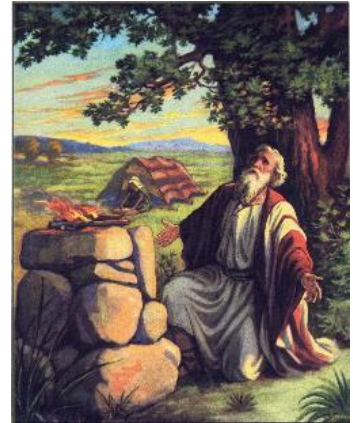


Legend

 Pink = Females

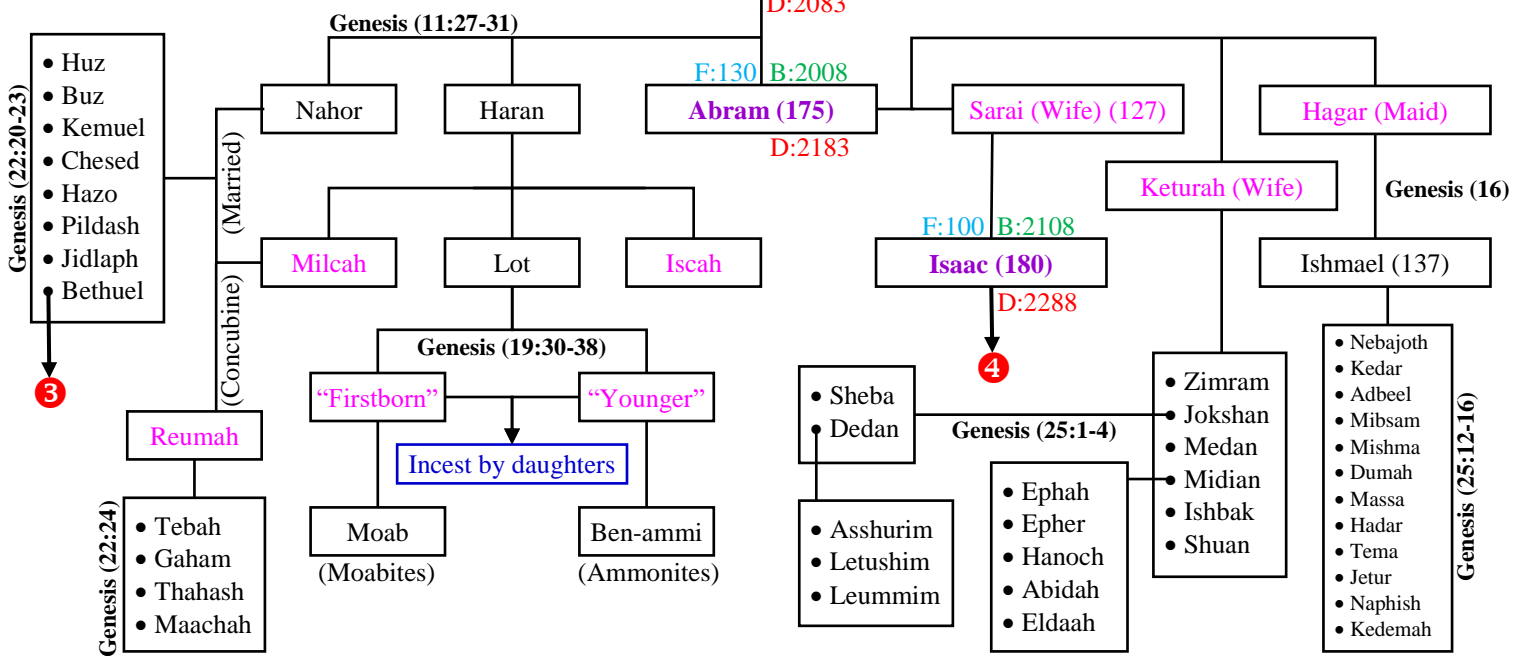


Continental Split Theory

- See Genesis (10:25) & 1st Chronicles (1:19)
- *“To Eber were born two sons: the name of one was Peleg, for in his days the earth was divided”*
- “Peleg” means to divide land with water channels.
- This was probably the continental split event that gave us our current continental configurations.
- This is not the “scattering” of the people/nations that occurred at Babylon (Tower of Babel).
- This was 100+ years after Noah released the animals from the ark. This allowed the animals time to multiply and migrate to their proper habitats before the continental split occurred.
- The continents also had to be together in order for Noah to gather all of the animals before the flood.
- The continental split created the Rockies, Andes, and Himalayas. These mountains are much higher/newer (pointier) than what existed during the days of Noah and the flood.
- This explains how the flood waters were able to cover the mountains because they were only the lower/older (rounded) ranges at that time.
- **NOTE:** Peleg was 1st son to die before his father.
