



34 - Miracles of The Prophets

Throughout the scriptures, God used certain men and prophets to perform miracles in order that His glory might be seen. Below is a partial list of some Old Testament miracles performed by several well known servants of God.



Miracles God Performed Through Moses

1	Turned the Nile and water sources to blood.	Exodus (7:14-24)
2	Frogs came up and infested the houses, courts, and fields.	Exodus (8:1-15)
3	The dust of the earth turned to gnats (lice) and infested all of the people and animals.	Exodus (8:16-19)
4	All of the houses of the Egyptians were infested with flies.	Exodus (8:20-32)
5	A plague of pestilence killed all of the Egyptian livestock that was in the field.	Exodus (9:1-7)
6	Boils and sores broke out on all of the people and animals of Egypt.	Exodus (9:8-12)
7	Hail mingled with fire destroyed the flax and barley harvest.	Exodus (9:13-25)
8	Remaining plants and fruits were destroyed by locusts.	Exodus (10:1-20)
9	An unnatural darkness fell over the land of Egypt making it so no Egyptian could see or go out.	Exodus (10:21-29)
10	The firstborn of every Egyptian family and every beast of the field was killed by "the Destroyer".	Exodus (11:1-12:36)
11	Israel was led by a pillar of cloud during the day and a pillar of fire at night.	Exodus (13:20-22)
12	The "Sea of Reeds" was parted allowing the Israelites to pass through its midst.	Exodus (14:1-22)
13	The "Sea of Reeds" closed upon the Egyptian army and drown them all.	Exodus (14:23-31)
14	The bitter water at "Marah" was made sweet by dropping a certain branch into it.	Exodus (15:22-27)
15	Abundant quail and "manna" fell from the sky to feed the Israelites.	Numbers (11:1-35)
16	Moses struck a rock with his staff and water poured forth for the thirsty Israelites.	Exodus (17:1-7)
17	By holding his staff over his head, Moses enabled the Israelites to defeat the Amalekites in battle.	Exodus (17:8-16)
18	Moses prayed and the leprosy of Miriam was cured.	Numbers (12:1-16)
19	The earth opened up and swallowed Korah & those who rebelled with him.	Numbers (16:1-35)
20	Israelites that were bitten by snakes were healed by looking at the bronze serpent on a pole.	Numbers (21:4-9)

Miracles God Performed Through Joshua

1	The Jordan River was stopped allowing the Israelites to pass over into the Promised Land.	Joshua (3:7-17)
2	The walls around the city of Jericho fell down after 7 days of marching around and shouting.	Joshua (6:1-27)
3	Large hail stones fell from Heaven and killed the Gibeonites.	Joshua (10:1-11)
4	The sun and moon stand still for about a whole day allowing the Israelites to finish off the Gibeonites.	Joshua (10:12-15)

Miracles God Performed Through Elijah

1	Elijah was able to control the rainfall based on his desire.	1 Kings (17:1)
2	He multiplied the flour and oil of an "obedient" widow and made it "bottomless".	1 Kings (17:7-16)
3	The dead son of a widow was resurrected by laying on top of him.	1 Kings (17:17-24)
4	Called down fire from Heaven to burn a soaking wet pile of wood, stones, and dust.	1 Kings (18:1-40)
5	Called up a rainstorm including clouds and wind.	1 Kings (18:41-45)
6	Outran Ahab's chariot and beat him to Jezreel.	1 Kings (18:46)
7	Predicted the death of King Ahaziah.	2 Kings (1:1-2)
8	100 soldiers and their Captains were killed by fire from Heaven.	2 Kings (1:9-17)
9	Parted the Jordan River with his "mantle" so that he and Elisha could cross on dry ground.	2 Kings (2:1-8)

Miracles God Performed Through Elisha

1	Used the "mantle" from Elijah to part the Jordan River and cross on dry ground.	2 Kings (2:13-14)
2	Cleansed a poison water source in the City of Elisha by putting a jar of salt into it.	2 Kings (2:19-22)
3	Sent 2 female bears to kill 42 young men who were mocking him for being bald.	2 Kings (2:23-25)
4	Flooded ditches with water that looked like blood in order to scare the Moabite armies.	2 Kings (3:1-27)
5	Filled up every available vessel with oil so a widow could pay off her debt.	2 Kings (4:1-7)
6	Predicted that a Shunammite woman would miraculously bear a son.	2 Kings (4:8-17)
7	Resurrected a Shunammite woman's son by laying on him and breathing into his mouth.	2 Kings (4:18-37)
8	Purified a pot of stew that was accidentally made of poisonous gourds.	2 Kings (4:38-44)
9	Healed Naaman's leprosy by having him dip 7 times in the Jordan River.	2 Kings (5:1-14)
10	Gehazi struck with leprosy for trying to steal a talent of silver and two changes of clothing.	2 Kings (5:15-27)
11	The head of a borrowed axe fell into the water and he made it float to retrieve it.	2 Kings (6:1-7)
12	Gives special sight to the king's messenger so he could see the invisible army of horses and chariots.	2 Kings (6:16-17)
13	Blinded the Armenian army and took them to Samaria as captives.	2 Kings (6:18-23)
14	A dead man was thrown into the grave with Elisha's bones and when he touched them he arose.	2 Kings (13:20-21)
