



39 - Parables Told by Jesus Christ

A parable is a simple story used to teach a lesson while hiding the true meaning or subject of the story. At a certain point in Jesus' ministry, He started using parables in order to hide the true meaning of what He was saying from unworthy people (**Matthew 13:10-17**). Many times, the apostles needed to come to Jesus and ask Him to explain the meaning of the parable to them. It seems many parables can only be understood through the guidance of the Holy Spirit. It should be noted that many of these are actually metaphors (comparing two unlike things) rather than parables.
