All About Angels

Introduction

Before God created man, He created angels. They are spiritual beings that play many roles in God's plan.

When Satan fell, he took 1/3 of the angels with him. Paul stated in his letter to the Ephesians:

[Ephesians (6:12)] "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

- 1) What does this mean to mankind?
- 2) What does this mean to us as Christians?

Read and briefly discuss the following passages:

Cherubim:

[Genesis 3:22-24] Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"--therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken. So He drove out the man; and He placed <u>cherubim</u> at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.

Lucifer (Satan):

[Ezekiel 28:14-16] "You were the anointed <u>cherub</u> who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you. "By the abundance of your trading You became filled with violence within, And you sinned; Therefore I cast you

as a profane thing Out of the mountain of God; And I destroyed you, O covering <u>cherub</u>, From the midst of the fiery stones.

Angels That Look Like Men:

[Genesis 18:2-3] So he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing by him; and when he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the ground, and said, "My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant.

[Genesis 19:1] Now the <u>two angels</u> came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them, and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground.

<u>Horses and Chariots of Fire (Invisibility Powers):</u>

[2 Kings 6:15-17] And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." And Elisha prayed, and said, "LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

Angel of the LORD ("Angel of Death"):

[Isaiah 37:36] Then the <u>angel of the LORD</u> went out, and killed in the camp of the Assyrians one hundred and eighty-five thousand; and when people arose early in the morning, there were the corpses--all dead.

Seraphim:

[Isaiah 6:1-3] In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above it stood <u>seraphim</u>; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

Archangel:

[Jude 1:9] Yet Michael the <u>archangel</u>, in contending with the devil, when he disputed about the body of Moses, dared not bring against him a reviling accusation, but said, "The Lord rebuke you!"

"Sons of God" (Angels Who Sinned):

[Genesis 6:1-4] Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, that the <u>sons of God</u> saw the daughters of men, that they were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose. And the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the <u>sons of God</u> came in to the daughters of men and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.

[2 Peter 2:4-5] For if God did not spare the <u>angels who sinned</u>, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment; and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

Visiting Angels:

[Hebrews 13:2] Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained <u>angels</u>.

Guardian Angels:

[Psalms 91:11] For He shall give His <u>angels</u> charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.

[Matthew 18:10] "Take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that in heaven their <u>angels</u> always see the face of My Father who is in heaven.

We Will Judge Angels:

[1 Corinthians 6:2-3] Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world will be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters? Do you not know that

we shall judge angels? How much more, things that pertain to this life?

Bound Angels:

[Revelation 9:13-15] Then the sixth angel sounded: And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind.
